We have audited, in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, the financial statements of the governmental activities and the major fund of Cayuga Tobacco Asset Securitization Corporation ("CTASC"), as of and for the year ended December 31, 2020, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise CTASC's basic financial statements, and have issued our report thereon dated March 16, 2021 (which report includes an emphasis of matter paragraph regarding the restatement of fund balance).

In connection with our audit, nothing came to our attention that caused us to believe that CTASC failed to comply with Section 2925(3)(f) of the New York State Public Authorities Law regarding investment guidelines during the year ended December 31, 2020. However, our audit was not directed primarily toward obtaining knowledge of such noncompliance. Accordingly, had we performed additional procedures, other matters may have come to our attention regarding CTASC's noncompliance with the above rules and regulations.
